Video on Demand, a new service from Miami University Libraries, is entering its second semester of use at GHL. Faculty members may request that Miami-owned videos and DVDs be encoded for viewing over the web. A link to the encoded video is then made available for faculty members to place in his or her Blackboard classroom. Students may view the videos on campus or from off-campus. Clickers Now Available!

A cooperative effort of the Educational Technology Center, the Center for Teaching and Learning, and the Gardner-Harvey Library is now making an expanded collection of Turning Point clickers available to the campus. Three sets of clickers (personal response systems) may now be checked out from the Library. Each set contains 30 clickers and a receiver. They may be checked out for 3 hours at one time. Blackboard Embedded Librarians'

Progress Report—Gardner-Harvey Embedded Librarians Burke and Tumbleson are glad to report the Blackboard Embedded Librarian program is entering its 3rd semester in Spring 2010. Five new faculty have joined the ranks along with nine returning faculty. The fourteen collaborating faculty are teaching seventeen courses of twenty three sections, from lower to upper division courses across the humanities, social sciences, and sciences in traditional classrooms and online, and reaching 500 students.

By creating customized library links, introducing research strategies, and addressing specific student questions via email, in-person, or in the classroom, librarians are fostering information literacy skills in students.

Academic research becomes less frustrating and more user-friendly. Student learning takes place through faculty-librarian collaboration. We discuss research assignments, tools and materials within the Miami University Libraries collection, and methods to develop more sophisticated searching by students. This win-win solution takes place in online learning space already familiar to Miami students. Library resources and services become available 24/7, whether on-campus or off.
