New Online Content for the Spring

New Information Literacy Content in <u>Credo Instruct</u>

In January 2019, 16 digital videos and tutorials with self-check activities were added to the Credo course. There are a new <u>video</u> and a <u>tutorial</u> on APA citations to help students understand and practice citing sources correctly. There are 2 new videos on <u>misinformation</u>. There are new videos on <u>primary sources</u> and <u>secondary sources</u>. Use any of the 6 modules or just 1 video, tutorial, or quiz with your class or an individual student to develop their academic research skills and understanding.

<u>DSM-5</u> Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders

The libraries at Miami now provide online access to the DSM-5 used by health professionals, nurses, social workers, forensic and legal specialists to diagnose and classify mental disorders. This online library includes the DSM-5, DSM-5 Handbook of Differential Diagnoses, DSM-5 Clinical Cases, and the Spanish edition.

Feb 6, 2019 - How to TEC: Design & Cut Vinyl, Operate a Heat Press
